College Program

General courses (including elective courses of physical education): The upper limit is 50 and the lower limit is 20.

Language courses (including courses offered by the Applied Chinese Department): The upper limit for general language courses is 50, and the lower limit is 15.

Courses on oral expression and writing: The upper limit is 40, and the lower limit is 15.

Courses on interpreting: The upper limit is 30, and the lower limit is 15.

Physical education courses: The upper limit is 50, and the lower limit is 30 (for compulsory courses).

The upper limit is 50, and the lower limit is 20 (for elective courses).

Junior College Program

General courses: The upper limit is 50 and the lower limit is 20.

Language courses (excluding courses offered by the Applied Chinese Department): The upper limit for general language courses is 50, and the lower limit is 15.

Courses on oral expression and writing: The upper limit is 40, and the lower limit is 15.

Courses on interpreting: The upper limit is 30, and the lower limit is 15.

Physical education courses: The upper limit is 50, and the lower limit is 30.

Continuing Education Program

Second foreign language courses for the English Department of the Four-year College: The upper limit is 50, and the lower limit to offer two classes is 65.

Note:

If departments need to adjust the numbers of upper limit and lower limit due to special circumstances, official request for approval should be submitted.
