

## FAQ for Course Enrollment

### Q1. How do I log in course enrollment system?

① WZU Homepage→Login “Information Service”



② Enter account number (Student ID) and password. Enter the randomly generated letters and numbers in the “Captcha image” and click on “Log in.”



③ Click on “Course Selection Operations System.”



### Q2. What courses should I enroll in 4-year university?

Ans. Students are required to complete their course enrollment according to the curriculum requirements designated by WZU and their major program established for their class level since their first year of admission. **Q3. What is General Education Courses?**

Ans. For the required general education courses, Four-year College students of Day Division must choose one course each from Humanities & Arts group and Social Sciences group, and two from the Science group, for a total of 8 credits. Elective general education courses can be chosen in the 3rd year. The Science group courses for students who enrolled in the 2016 academic year and after are divided into two subgroups—A and B. Students must choose one 2-credit course from each subgroup.

**Q4. What is “Department Electives” and “General Elective courses”?**

Ans. The elective courses offered by each department are department electives for students in that department. While for students from different departments, those courses only count as general elective courses. (Different in credit)

**Q5. How many credits could I register every semester?**

Ans. Every semester, students of university division must register for a minimum of 10 credits and a maximum of 27 credits.
